# The Story of the Beltline Bar

The Beltline Bar was opened in 1953 by George Wilkinson. Beltline Bar was a fitting name considering 28th Street was commonly referred to as “The Beltline.” In 1964, Tony Rutkowski acquired the restaurant and it became known as “Little Tony’s Beltline Bar” and the Grand Rapids facility only seated 42 people in a single room. At this time, a total of 3 employees served beer, wine, popcorn & chili dogs. In 1966, a liquor license was acquired, and Tony’s son Jerry developed recipes for several Mexican specialties, including the WORLD-FAMOUS WET BURRITO. The restaurant developed a catchy jingle and adopted the name “Beltline Bar’s Famous Mexican Cafe”.

In October of 2001, Jerry decided it was time to retire, and entrusted Grand Rapids restaurateur Jeff Lobdell to own and operate the Beltline Bar, a community staple, just like Jerry’s father had entrusted him.

Today, the Beltline Bar seats 250 people and has undergone numerous improvements to better serve our guests. We offer curbside to go, off-site catering, including taco and burrito bars, a party pleasing Margarita bar and online ordering. Some things have changed over the years, but not our original spice recipes that were created back in the 60’s and are still kept secret. Our scratch kitchen essentially makes everything fresh in-house including our refried beans, rice, sauces, chips, salsa, queso, and guacamole. Our aged colby cheese comes in 40-pound blocks and is hand grated daily. Our fresh ground beef is provided to us by a local butcher because we love local. The Beltline Bar’s WORLD-FAMOUS WET BURRITO is still number one in the hearts of our loyal customers.

Locally, the Beltline Bar has been recognized for our charitable giving and has received numerous awards including multiple years as Grand Rapids best Mexican restaurant, best margarita and favorite wet burrito. Nationally, Beltline Bar has been recognized for having a top 5 burrito in the country by ‘Food and Wine Magazine’ and was recently featured on ‘Travel Channel’ in an episode of their hit show ‘Man V Food’.

Fun Facts about some of the most popular ingredients that go into our in-house made menu items each year at Beltline Bar:

- 45,000 individual avocados in our fresh-made guacamole
- 30,000 pounds of locally sourced ground beef
- 28,000 pounds of fresh tomatoes in our pico de gallo and salsas
- 50,000 pounds of in-house grated, aged colby cheese
- 53,000 pounds of daily, fresh fried tortilla chips
- Over 5.3 million burritos served... and counting!!
